

HOW IS A MENA ELCA ACTION ALERT MADE?

STEP 1

Action alerts are identified based on unfolding situation on the ground in the MENA region, including Palestine and Israel

STEP 2

ELCA WiS Staff identify if there is currently legislation which matches this issue

STEP 4

This language is sent to ELCA WiS senior staff who check the language for effectiveness and accuracy.

STEP 3

If there is appropriate legislation, WiS Staff work with the MENA staff to draft language that constituents can use to urge their legislators to sign on to the bill in question.

STEP 5

Once approved, the action alert gets added to a queue to be published on the ELCA Website, and sent to Action Alert email list recipients.

STEP 6

ELCA Action Alert recipients receive their action alert, and contact their legislators.

ELCA= Evangelical Lutheran Church in America

MENA= Middle East/North Africa

WiS= Witness in Society (ELCA Advocacy)
